**Minimum Charges.** The minimum rental fee is 1.5x the daily rental rate. Monthly (4 weeks) rentals are 3x the weekly rate. Weekly (7 days) rentals are charged at 5x the daily rate.

**Shipping Charges.** Shipping is billed at \$3.00 per pound of Rented Equipment shipped. This rate doubles if Customer ships Rented Equipment back to GE, using GE's shipping account number. Counter-to-Counter shipments are performed at Customer's request, and a minimum \$350 fee applies. Weekend and holiday shipments are subject to an additional handling fee of \$350.

**Optional Limited Liability Coverage.** Optional limited liability coverage is added to rentals at \$60 per day, unless declined with a signature below. LIMITED LIABILITY COVERAGE CANNOT BE DECLINED FOR SPECIALTY VIDEOPROBES. This coverage includes a \$3,000 deductible (\$4,000 for Specialty Videoprobes) for each incident of loss. Total loss of Rented Equipment as a result of theft, destruction or otherwise is not covered by this liability limitation. Decline: (Customer Initial)

**Terms & Conditions of Rental.** This rate schedule is governed by the GE Inspection Technologies Terms & Conditions of Rental attached hereto. Placement of a rental order constitutes acceptance of such terms and conditions, without modification.

**Credit towards New Equipment Purchase.** Amounts paid for rentals (other than for damage or cleaning) may be applied to new equipment purchases (purchased equipment must be of the same model as Rented Equipment), as follows (excludes push cameras, crawlers, fiberscopes/borescopes):

- \* 100% of the rental fee (not to exceed one week) will be applied to purchase orders received during the rental term.
- \* 50% of the rental fee (not to exceed one week) will be applied to purchase orders received within 30 days of the end of rental term.
- \* 25% of the rental fee (not to exceed one week) will be applied to purchase orders received 31-60 days after the end of rental term.

### GE's TERMS & CONDITIONS OF RENTAL ("T&Cs")

- Rental and Other Payments.** The rental term starts the date Rented Equipment is delivered to Customer FCA GE's facility. Rental fees accrue from delivery through and including the day GE receives Rented Equipment ("Return Date"). Rentals for less than four weeks will be invoiced on the Return Date, subject to inspection by GE. Rentals for more than four weeks will be invoiced on a monthly basis, in arrears and on the Return Date. Except as otherwise agreed to by GE in writing, Customer shall pay GE all invoiced amounts in U.S. dollars, without right of set-off, within 30 days from invoice date. Customer may not retain Rented Equipment beyond the scheduled return date without the prior consent of GE. Customer shall pay all collection charges, including reasonable attorneys' fees, if payment is not received when due. Customer will pay for any sales and use taxes, other direct taxes and registration fees imposed by any taxing authority and related directly or indirectly to Customer's use or possession of Rented Equipment, excluding taxes relating to GE income. Customer shall not acquire any right, title or interest in the Rented Equipment, except the right to possess and use Rented Equipment so long as Customer is not in default under these T&Cs.
- Delivery and Inspection.** Customer has sole responsibility, at its cost, to obtain all approvals required for Customer's lawful operation and possession of Rented Equipment. The parties agree that Rented Equipment was inspected by GE prior to shipment and examined by Customer upon delivery and is in good and serviceable condition.
- Use and Maintenance of Equipment.** Customer, at its sole cost, will keep Rented Equipment at all times until the Return Date in good repair and operating condition, subject to ordinary wear and tear, and free of any and all liens and encumbrances. Customer shall use Rented Equipment in a careful manner and such use and possession shall comply with all laws. GE will have the right to inspect Rented Equipment, and if GE believes Rented Equipment to be misused, GE may summarily remove and repossess Rented Equipment. Customer will not use or store Hazardous Substances in or around Rented Equipment. Unless agreed to in writing with GE, Customer will not locate Rented Equipment at a remediation or nuclear site or use Rented Equipment for medical laboratory testing. "Hazardous Substances" means hazardous, toxic, radioactive or bio-hazardous substances or petroleum products. Ordinary wear and tear does not include contamination by Hazardous Substances. If any returned Rented Equipment is contaminated by Hazardous Substances during Customer's possession, GE may charge Customer for the clean up or may require Customer to purchase Rented Equipment at the then current market price charged for an uncontaminated unit. Customer agrees that Rented Equipment will not be used by any person other than Customer or its agents or employees. Rented Equipment must be operated by trained and experienced personnel. Rented Equipment is not waterproof and should not be used in underwater applications. Contact GE to verify Rented Equipment's water resistance. Rented Equipment is not intrinsically safe or explosion proof and should not be used in hazardous environments.
- NO WARRANTY. THERE ARE NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AND ALL WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING ANY EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR PURPOSE, ARE HEREBY EXCLUDED.**
- Limitation of Damages.** Customer expressly waives any and all claims for loss of profits or other alleged consequential, incidental or punitive damages arising out of or in connection with these T&Cs. GE is not liable for any loss or damage to any property stored, located or transported in, upon, under or around any Rented Equipment. In no event shall GE's liability under these T&Cs exceed the rental fees received by GE hereunder. GE shall not be liable to Customer for any loss, delay or damage of any kind or character resulting from defects in or inefficiencies of Rented Equipment or accidental breakage thereof. GE is not responsible to any party for misused testing procedures or misinterpretation of Rented Equipment test data.
- Return of Equipment.** Upon the completion of the rental period, Customer will promptly return Rented Equipment, via priority overnight shipping, to the GE location from which Rented Equipment originated. Rented Equipment must be returned in the same condition in which it was received and in clean, working condition, ordinary wear and tear excluded. GE reserves the right to apply a cleaning fee of \$100, if Rented Equipment is not returned in same condition. Customer agrees to pay the full cost for any damage to or loss of Rented Equipment, while in the possession or control of Customer, subject to Optional Limited Liability Coverage paid for by Customer.
- Indemnification.** Customer specifically indemnifies, agrees to defend and holds harmless GE its employees and agents from any and all loss, claims, liabilities, damages, fines, forfeitures, seizures, penalties and expenses (including attorneys' fees and investigative costs) (collectively "Losses") that may arise from or in connection with: (i) the loss of or damage to Rented Equipment because of collision, fire, lightning or theft, flood, windstorm or explosion, civil disturbance or riot or any other peril or casualty (subject to Customer's election of Optional Limited Liability Coverage hereunder); (ii) the death of or injury to, including but not limited to, damage to the property of, any person (other than Rented Equipment) as a result of, in whole or in part, the use or condition prior to the Return Date or (iii) the actual or alleged storage, maintenance, use, handling, repair, or operation of Rented Equipment, prior to the Return Date. The obligations contained in this Section will survive expiration or termination of the term of these T&Cs and the Return Date.
- Default.** The occurrence of one or more of the following will constitute an "Event of Default" under these T&Cs: (i) Customer fails to pay when due any amount due hereunder; (ii) Customer fails to observe any other term or condition under these T&Cs and such failure remains unremedied for more than ten days after such failure to perform or observe; or (iii) Customer becomes insolvent, becomes subject to any voluntary or involuntary bankruptcy or reorganization proceedings, makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors, appoints or submits to the appointment of a receiver for all or any of its assets, admits in writing its inability to pay its debts as they become due or enters into any type of voluntary or involuntary liquidation or dissolution. Upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, GE will have the option to retake and retain any or all of Rented Equipment free of all rights of Customer without any further liability or obligation to redeliver any of Rented Equipment to Customer, and Customer hereby grants GE the right to enter upon any premises where Rented Equipment is located to take possession of and remove such Rented Equipment. The remedies provided in favor of GE are cumulative and in addition to all other remedies existing at law or in equity. No action taken by GE pursuant to this Section will release Customer from its obligations under these T&Cs.
- Miscellaneous.** Customer will not have the right to assign these T&Cs or to sublet, rent or otherwise hire out or transfer possession of any of Rented Equipment to any person or entity other than GE, without the prior written consent of GE. GE may assign these T&Cs. These T&Cs contain the entire agreement between the parties pertaining to the rental of Rented Equipment. These T&Cs are governed by the laws of the State of New York, without regard to choice of law principles thereof.
